General 4-H & FFA Agriculture Division Rules:

1. Refer to:
 - a. **General Rules**, see pages 4 – 5.
 - b. **Open Agriculture Rules**, see page 6.
 - c. **Health Requirements**, see pages 7 – 8.
2. No entry fees are charged with the exception of Department [22], Meat Goats.
3. All exhibitors must be bonafide members of 4H/FFA or other youth in the state of Virginia - who are at least 9 years of age by Sept 30 of the current year and have not had their 19th birthday before Jan 1st of the current year.
4. **Space at the Fair is limited.** First priority acceptance into the Prince William County Fair will be given to entrants from the following:
 - a. Counties: Prince William, Fauquier, Loudoun, Fairfax, Rappahannock, Shenandoah, Culpeper, Stafford, Madison, Orange, Caroline, Greene, Spotsylvania, King George, Louisa, Albemarle, Fluvanna, Nelson, and Arlington
 - b. Cities: Manassas and Manassas Park
 - c. It is up to the discretion of each individual department superintendent to allow entrants from other counties.
5. All registration forms must be mailed to **Prince William County Fair, P.O. Box 91, Manassas, VA 20108** no later than Friday, July 30, 2010.
6. All animals exhibited must be fitted and shown by the exhibitor, except classes in which the exhibitor has more than one (1) exhibit. Additional exhibits must be shown by another youth, 4-H, or FFA exhibitor.
7. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor and all animals entered in breeding classes must be registered in exhibitor's name with registration papers from breed association available to Fair officials upon request. Animals with multiple ownership on registration papers may be exhibited in the Junior Show as long as all owners are identified on registration papers and on entry forms.
8. Showing and fitting ages will be based on age as of September 30 of the current year.
9. A novice showing and fitting class will be added if there are three or more eligible exhibitors.
10. To be eligible for all prizes and awards, youth, 4-H, and FFA members must take full responsibility for the care of their animals for the duration of their stay at the fair.
