Breeds:

First Show: La Manchas, Nubians, Recorded Grades,
and Oberhasli

Second Show: Saanen, Toggenburgs, Alpine, and
Nigerian, plus Unregistered Does(▲)

Barn space is limited. **Entries will be closed when barn is full.**

Entry Limitations:

Exhibitors are limited to 15 animals each regardless of
the number of exhibitors from one farm.

Only 45 animals from any one farm will be allowed to
enter.

Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per class.

Age of animals will be computed as of the day of the show. Age
of exhibitors will be computed as of January 1, 2010.

Substitutions will be allowed at check in: **must be within class
and breed only.**

All registration papers will be checked prior to each show.

All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. No
stamped duplicates allowed.

In each group class (2107, 2117), an individual animal may be a
member of only one group. No overlapping of groups will be
allowed within the class. **Only one (1) group per exhibitor.**

There will be no pre-show milkout. Overdistended udders will be
discriminated against.

Animals used in the Showing and Fitting Classes must be entered
in the regular classes of this department.

Animals shown in this department must be registered in the name
of the exhibitor (exception: showing and fitting classes 2122
– 2125). No joint, family, or farm ownerships accepted.
