RULES:	
Refer to:	a.) General Rules, pp. 4 – 5 b.) Youth, 4-H, & FFA Ag Division Rules, p. 50
Breeds: Any standard breed found in Rabbit Standards. No mixed rabbits may be shown.	
All rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor.	
The Fair will furnish coops, litter for coops, and feed during the week. Exhibitors will be held responsible for loss or damage from any cause.	
No exhibitor may show more than 10 entries. Entries will close when coop capacity is met.	
All entries will be judged according to their individual quality. For example: if the best entry in a class does not meet Blue Ribbon standards, it will be awarded a Second Place.	
Barn Rules:	
Cages will be cleaned by exhibitors from 9:00 – 10:00 a.m. daily.	
No animals allowed out of cages after 10:00 a.m.	
Exhibitors who do not clean their animals' cages daily will forfeit all premium moneys.	
4-H members must clean their own cages.
