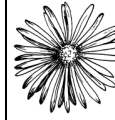

RULES:

In order to have an attractive display at all times during the fair, all entries of a perishable nature will be entered and judged on two separate occasions. Please pay careful attention to specific entry and release times of exhibits you are entering. *See page 21 for details.*

Each class will be divided into three age groups:

8 & under (0 – 8)

9 – 13

14 – 19

Specimens:

Display bottles are provided by the Fair.

At least one set of leaves should be showing above the container.

Stem supports may be used below top of container (i.e. cotton).

All specimens must be grown by exhibitor.

Arrangements:

Flowers for arrangements do not need to be grown by exhibitor.

No artificial, fabric, or craft flowers may be used.

Arrangements should not exceed 15" in diameter.

Fruits and vegetables should never be cut.

The flag of the United States should not be displayed in a flower arrangement.
