<b><u>Rules applicable only to Breeding Hogs:</u></b>	
<b>Breeds:</b>	Berkshire, Hampshire, Poland, China, Duroc, Landrace, and Yorkshire. Each breed is shown separately.
<b><u>Rules applicable only to Market Hogs:</u></b>	
	All breeds compete together. Females may be shown in market classes. One (1) barrow from a pen of three (3) may be shown as a single barrow. The Fair reserves the right to require weighing on the morning of showing. Affidavits may be required to show ownership at least three days prior to the Fair.
