ADGA Show Rules Shall Govern

Junior & Senior Doe Shows are not separately sanctioned.
Unofficial 4-H shows will also be held both days.

RULES:

Entry Fee: \$4.00 for each animal.

Barn Space and Entry Limitations:

Barn space is limited. **Entries will be closed when barn is full.**

Exhibitors are limited to 15 animals each regardless of the number of exhibitors from one farm.

Only 45 animals from any one farm will be allowed to enter.

Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per individual class and 1 entry per group class (407, 418, 420, 421) and "Best Udder" class 419. **Maximum group class per farm is 3.**

Only animals being exhibited may stay in the barn. No bucks of any age will be allowed.

If barn space is available, we will try to accommodate exhibitors who have animals entered in both shows so that their animals may remain in place all week.

Age of animals will be computed as of the day of the show.

Substitutions will be allowed at check in: **must be within class and breed only.**

All registration papers will be checked prior to each show.

All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. No stamped duplicates allowed.

In each group class (407, 418, 420, 421), an individual animal may be a member of only one group. No overlapping of groups will be allowed within the class. **Only one (1) group per exhibitor.**

In Dairy Herd Class (421), Junior Herd (407), and Produce of Dam (420), an entry must be comprised of does from the same herd, owned by one person, or by members of the same family.

There will be no pre-show milkout. Overdistended udders will be discriminated against.
