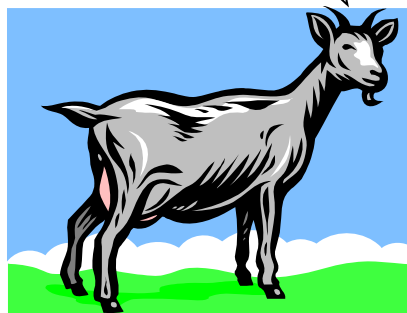

4-H is the youth development education program conducted by the Virginia Cooperative Extension.

4-H programs are delivered to the community primarily through community clubs. Youth and adults participate in projects, activities, camps, conferences and other learn by doing experiences.

4-H members choose projects ranging from gardening, wildlife, sewing, marine science, ecology, cooking, animal science, computers and many other subjects of interest to today's suburban/rural youth.

The 4-H experience provides more than additional knowledge. Activities are designed to teach the following life skills:

Communicating and Relating to Others

Acquiring, Analyzing and Using Information

Problem Solving and Decision Making

Managing Resources

Working with Others

4-H is available to all youth, ages 5-18.

Children ages 5-8 are enrolled in Cloverbud clubs.

Projects, activities, and camps are specially designed for each age group.

Clubs are organized by community volunteers with training, help and materials from the 4-H staff at Prince William County Cooperative Extension.
