2.) Breeds:	Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein, Jersey.
3.) Grades may be shown, but up to date project books on grades must be presented showing proof that animals were carried as projects for the year. Each breed must be exhibited separately. No cross breeds can be shown.	
4.) Any cow in milk and under 2 years must be shown in the Junior 2-year-old class (1810).	
5.) No calves born after 4/30/08 may be shown.	
6.) All milking cows must be milked in the milking parlor except on show day.
